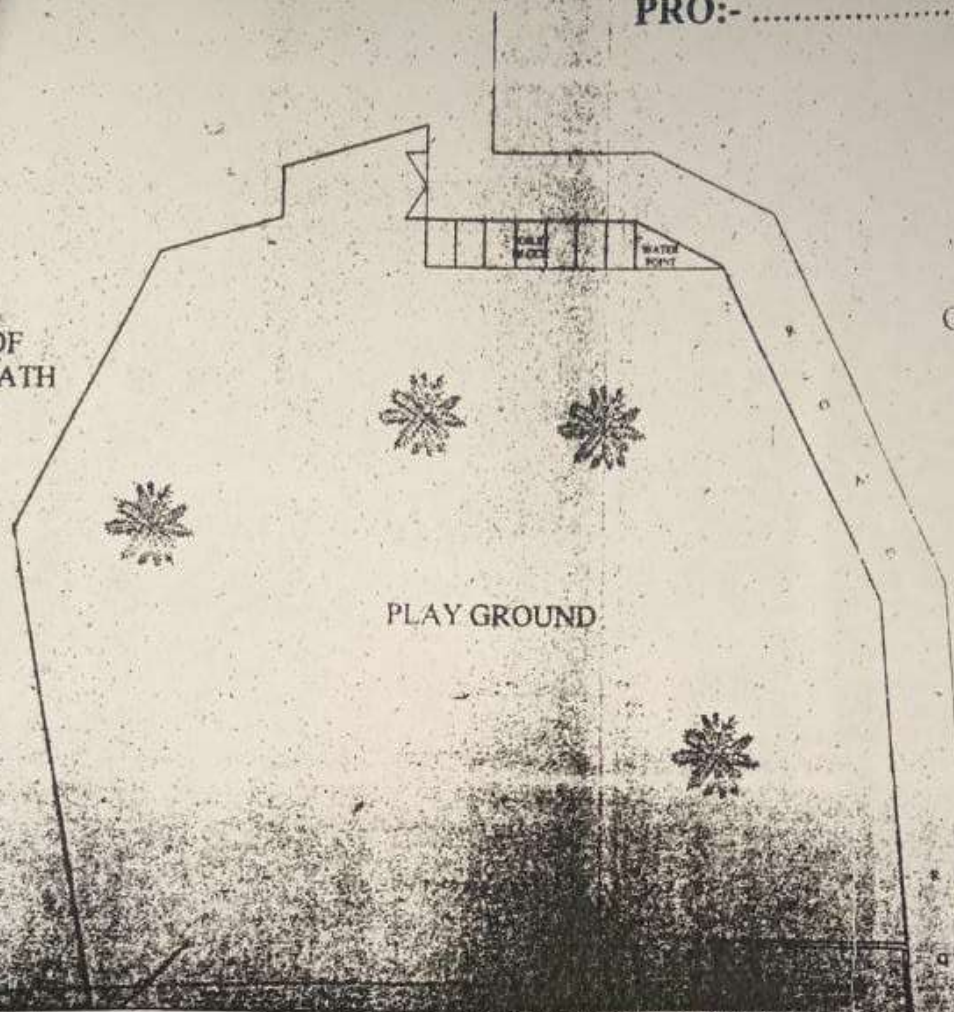

AT KARWANDA (BHALWAL)

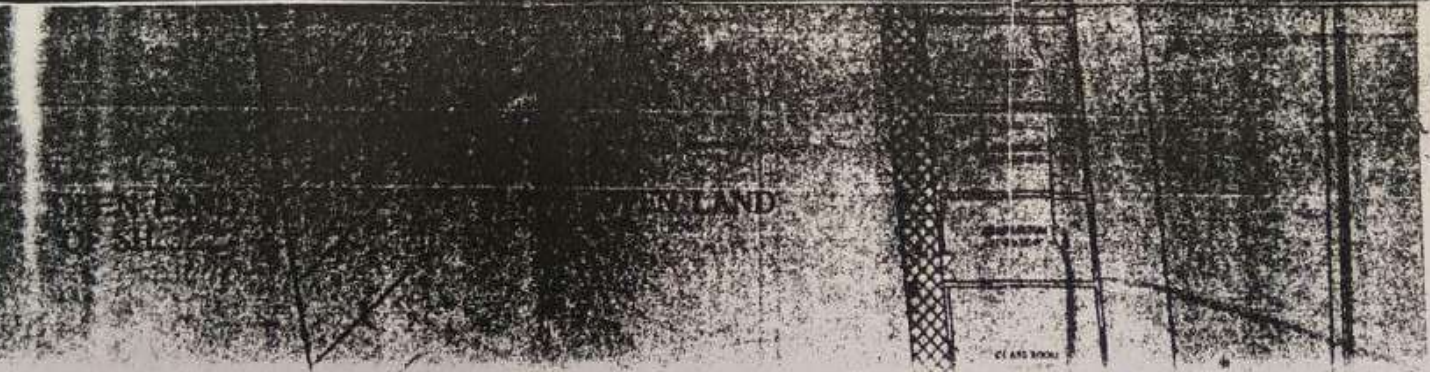

Ref: Your online application submission dated: 12.03.2023 (FI-649721).

The inspection of above said school was got carried out by the inspecting officer of this department. During inspection it was found that the management has installed 02 Nos. of Hose Reel Hoses and 13 Nos. of First Aid Fire Extinguishers in their school premises. Besides this, one water storage tank of 10 KL capacity is also available. The school is about 09 Km away from Fire and Emergency Station Roop Nagar and is approachable for fire appliances in case of any emergency. Since the school is already functioning, as such, the management can proceed ahead for operation subject to adopt the following fire safety measures/guidelines in letter and spirit forthwith:-

1. Manual Operated Fire Alarm System should be installed in the school premises.
2. All exits/entrances should be kept open and free from any obstruction for easy and safe evacuation of inmates during any emergency.
3. All electric installations existing in the building should be concealed conduit type.
4. First Aid Fire fighting system installed in the school building should be checked periodically. Staff and students should be fully trained in handling / operating of fire fighting system installed in the school building. The management shall intimate this office in writing after each quarter that the fire fighting equipments installed in the school are functioning.
5. All class rooms and examination halls having seating capacity for more than 45 students need to be provided with two exits.
6. The corridor of the building shall not be used for any kind of storage.
7. No Hazardous material should be kept inside of the school premises (especially LPG cylinder, Petrol and Diesel etc.). Any deviation found in this regard, this clearance will be treated automatically withdrawn/cancelled.
8. The management shall be wholly and solely responsible for keeping the fire fighting system in working condition 24x7 and safe evacuation of its students during any mishap.
9. At present school is having two blocks, one is double storied and another is triple storied. As such no addition / alteration should be made by the school management in the existing structure without prior information from this department. Any deviation found in this regard, this clearance will be treated automatically withdrawn/cancelled.
10. The department can make a surprise visit to your school at any time. During the visit if the fire fighting system (i.e. existing as well as proposed) found defunct and deviation, this clearance issued shall be treated automatically withdrawn/cancelled.
11. This clearance shall be subject to outcome of any dispute/investigation/ enquiry/ trial if any, pending before any Court of Law/investigation agency. This clearance shall not confirm any title upon the person/company in whose favour it is issued.
12. The validity of this clearance shall remain in force for one year and same needs to be renewed after checking of fire fighting system installed in the school building. However, before granting permission/recognition/ extension or renewal thereof, the authority concerned shall satisfy himself in terms of conditions laid down in SRO-123 of 2010, issued by Education Department with regard to physical facilities and also ensure the fire safety measures/guidelines given to the proprietor by this department are fully complied with.

JUDGMENT


Plaintiff has filed a civil suit for declaration to the effect that he is owner, as a legal heir, of suit premises consisting of land measuring 4 kanals 13 marlas falling in Survey nos. 3374min (6 marlas) and 3375 (4 kanals 7marlas) Khata No. 2234 min and Khewat No. 24 min, situated at Karwandha, Bhalwal, Tehsil Jammu, alongwith a double storey building there upon—to the exclusion of defendants. Plaintiff also seeks a consequential relief of permanent prohibitory injunction restraining the defendants from interfering in the aforementioned property, hereinafter referred to as 'suit property'.

Plaintiff seeks relief as aforementioned on the premise that his father was the sole owner of the suit property and in order to settle him during his life time, the deceased father of the plaintiff handed over the possession of suit land to him (plaintiff) to start a school on the said land. Further, the case of the plaintiff is that it was during the life time of his deceased father, when the suit property was given to plaintiff by way of family settlement and plaintiff has been enjoying the suit property as sole owner. Now, the grievance of the plaintiff is that after the death of his father on 20-4-2009, who died intestate, defendants have started interfering in the suit premises and hence the suit.


Defendants were put on service. They caused appearance and submitted written statement on 10-3-2010. It is pertinent to indicate here that defendant have admitted the suit of the plaintiff as a whole. Preliminary statements of parties under Order 10 of CPC were also recorded and made part of the file. By way of abundant caution, a publication for the information of public in general inviting objections to the claim of plaintiff was also directed to be published. Accordingly, said publication appears to have been published in " KATTU SATYA" in its issue of 18th May 2010. Same is also placed on record. Nobody appeared and filed any objections to the claim of plaintiff as a consequence of response to said publication.

Now the submission of Id. counsel for plaintiff is that since whole of the claim of plaintiff stands admitted by defendants, it, therefore, is incumbent according to Id. counsel, upon this court to decree the suit.

Ld. counsel for defendants stuck to the stand taken by defendants in their written statement and therefore, did not resist the contention of Id. counsel for plaintiff.







- It will be obligatory to stick strictly to the curriculum adopted by the BOSE for all classes and prescribe Books covering that curriculum, especially published by the BOSE. Also to ensure arrangement for co-curricular and extracurricular activities for the students.
- To maintain hygiene & sanitation, there should be separate toilets for boys and girls. An additional facility of change room is to be made available to the Girl students and First Aid facilities should also be available.
- Parent Teacher Association as required under norms has to be there alongwith Management Committee to ensure the Academic Development.
- The EPF/CPF (whichever is applicable) is to be maintained with the required contributions towards the fund.
- It shall be obligatory upon all the affiliated Academic Institutions to obtain recognition orders from School Education Department.
- The previous period for which the provisional release of facilities was granted by the BOSE authorities from time to time in favour of the institutions is also regularized with the condition that the institution will deposit affiliation fee for previous period as per BOSE norms.
- All the institutions shall ensure the renewal of all certificates as are envisaged in SRO-292 dated 2nd July 2018.
- The institutions that are granted five years extension in affiliation/up-gradation shall deposit an Annual Inspection Fee of Rs. 3500/- (Rupees Three Thousand and Five hundred only) for the first three years as per Notification No. F(Acad-C)Affil-Insp-Fee/17 dated 05-07-2017, issued by Director Academics, JKBOSE.
- The institutions which are running for more than 15 years and affiliated with BOSE, located in the heart of city shall submit their undertaking before the Board that they are not in a position to construct the building for examination hall due to shortage of land and also cannot arrange the examination hall on rent basis, it was further resolved that such institutions in the meantime shall construct the examination hall or make alternate arrangements for such examination hall in the adjoining areas of the institution within said period of one year.
- It is mandatory for all the institutions that requests for extension cases must come as per the Affiliation calendar fixed by the BOSE i.e. One year earlier to the expiry period of Affiliation.
